

## Information Notice on

### **Proposed Part VIII Grangegorman Upper, Dublin 7 - Footpath & Road Improvement Scheme**

Dublin City Council proposes to seek Part VIII planning approval to carry out the Grangegorman Upper Footpath & Road Improvement Scheme. The scheme proposes increased footpath widths along Grangegorman Upper on both sides of the road to accommodate a new one way system along Grangegorman Upper from North Circular Road towards Grangegorman Lower.

The proposal will also include an enhanced public realm in proximity to a new Primary School entrance (at Grangegorman Upper). The works primarily comprise of upgrading the existing streetscape to provide a more pedestrian friendly environment and enhanced mobility impaired access.

Various environmental improvements are proposed including new landscaping, seating and bicycle parking.

The proposed works include an overall enhancement along Grangegorman Upper. The works along Grangegorman Upper will include:

- Increased footpath widths along Grangegorman Upper on both sides of the road to accommodate a new one way system along Grangegorman Upper from North Circular Road towards Grangegorman Lower.
- A simplified junction arrangement at Grangegorman Upper and Rathdown Road.
- Proposal to name the public space resulting from the revised junction arrangement, "Rathdown Place".
- The provision of landscaping, seating and new bicycle parking at "Rathdown Place".
- A reconfiguration of car parking along Grangegorman Upper but with no reduction in spaces for local residents.
