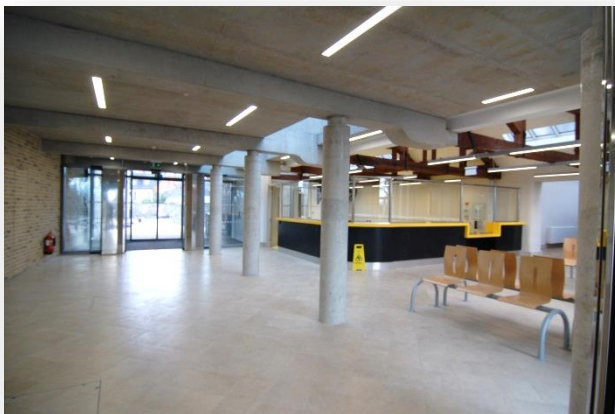

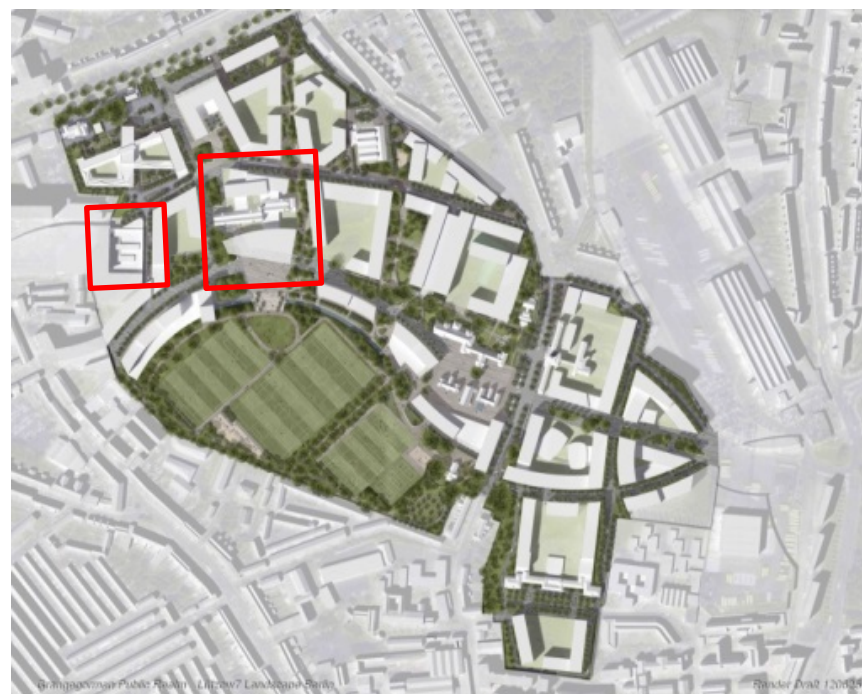

- Progressing work around referral pathways, programme sustainability and evaluation.

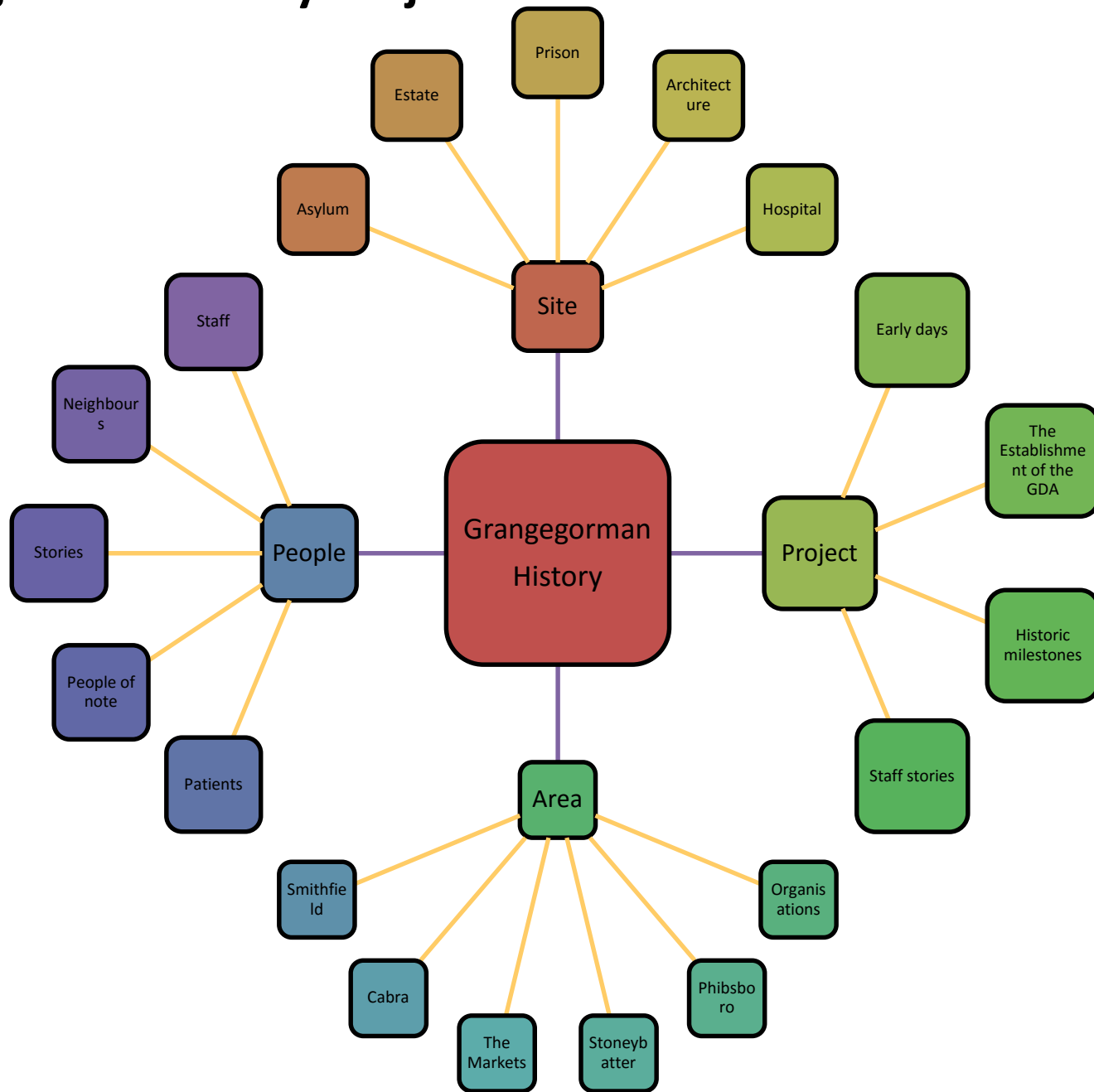
