



Grangegorman Histories invites applications from individuals and organisations for funding to support a project that explores and shares any element of the history of Grangegorman, in keeping with its public history values.


Grangegorman Histories' mission is to provide opportunities to contribute to the important work of uncovering, cataloguing and commemorating the eventful history of this site and surrounding areas. We welcome projects that support the implementation of the activities detailed in our current [Implementation Plan](#). A list of completed and ongoing activities can be found on our [website](#). We will consider proposals that aim at expanding any of the work already done, and also welcome projects from different disciplines, including but not limited to the creative arts, food history, botany and environmental studies, architecture and design, and employing different formats, like physical or digital trails, culinary experiences, webinars and workshops, audio and video materials, or traditional print literature. Outputs from successful applicants' projects must be shared in the public domain. Such outputs may be digital in whole or in part.

Grangegorman Histories is a public history project of Dublin City Council, Grangegorman Development Agency, HSE, Local Communities, National Archives, Royal Irish Academy and TU Dublin. Established in 2019, the project provides opportunities to contribute to the important work of uncovering, cataloguing and commemorating the history of the Grangegorman area.

Applications must be received on or before 17.00 on Friday, 29 September 2023. Projects must be delivered by 12 months from date of funding notification.

Join author and historian Fergus Whelan for a walking tour which will pass through Grange Gorman, Broadstone Station, the Kings Inns, Registry of Deeds, 14 Henrietta St and Na Piobairí Uilleann, all of which have their own Culture Night events. Bookings for this tour will go live at 10am on Tuesday, 5th September, when the full Culture Night Supported Tours Programme is published. Booking is essential for these tours as places are limited.

**14 Henrietta Street - ISL Tour**

This tour will be delivered exclusively in ISL. When you enter 14 Henrietta Street you'll experience over 300 years of city and family life in the walls of one address. By connecting to the personal stories of those who called 14 Henrietta Street home, the building's hidden histories are revealed. See the house, reveal its stories and discover the layers of Dublin history within its walls. Duration of the tour is 75 minutes. This tour is an indoor experience however all windows and doors are open for ventilation, so please dress warmly and wear comfortable shoes. Please note there will not be a translation for this tour.

Walking Tours  
Meeting point: Grangegorman Lower, the concourse outside the East Quad

In the past 250 years, Grangegorman, on the northside of Dublin city centre, has been the site of a workhouse, a hospital, a prison and it is now integrating back into the city as a health and education campus for the HSE, TU Dublin and the local community. The historical buildings of Grangegorman stand as architectural monuments to its past and complex history. In this guided tour, we will explore the site's eleven protected structures and share some of those histories.

**Registry of Deeds: Tailte Éireann**

The Registry of Deeds Archive Services forms part of the Registration Services of Tailte Éireann. For Culture Night 2023, doors will be open to visitors for tours of the Registry of Deeds. The tour will focus on the architectural features of the beautiful James Gandon designed building and our historical records dating back to 1708. The tour will include an introduction to 'how to search' and a peek at some famous signatories on our memorials from Ireland's cultural past. 30-minute tours will be held every hour.

**Bus Éireann Broadstone**

Guided Tour  
Broadstone, Dublin 7

Built between 1841 and 1850, and known as the 'Director's House', the building was designed by John Skipton Mulvaney and sat in front of a train shed offering rail access to points across the west of Ireland. Since the establishment of Ireland's national bus company, Bus Éireann, in February 1987, the building has operated as offices for Bus Éireann as part of the Broadstone bus depot. The historical walking tour of Broadstone is open to all members of the public who are eighteen years and over. Please note that only the ground floor of Broadstone building is wheelchair accessible.

Tours will take place every hour from 6-10pm – free admission, no booking required.

Dining Hall, King's Inns, Constitution Hill, D7

Founded in 1541, The Honorable Society of King's Inns is Ireland's Oldest School of Law. It is a key example of Ireland's Georgian architectural heritage and is one of Ireland's magnificent social venues, and features in films and television programmes like Penny Dreadful, Becoming Jane, and Ordinary Decent Criminals. Take a guided tour of the James Gandon designed Dining Hall, completed in 1806.

**Hidden History of Dublin Homes**

This Hidden Homes Dublin walking tour takes us off the beaten path to explore how homes have been at the heart of Dublin life through the ages. On Henrietta St we will see the first Dublin Georgian street, recalling the faded glory of these 1700's mansions, when Dublin was considered the second City of the old British Empire. We will also visit the Victorian Fruit and Veg markets, ripe for redevelopment, an old Jail and Courthouse used for Special Criminal Cases in the Troubles, before crossing over the River Liffey to see the old port of Dublin, ending the tour outside a Spy Bar.
