1. TU Dublin can confirm that we do not have any investments with exposure to Israeli companies.
2. The University has two Israeli companies on our list of suppliers, although there is no ongoing procurement with either.
3. The University does not have any active bilateral partnerships with Israeli academic institutions or companies.
4. We are a partner on a Horizon Europe research project aimed at investigating the use of AI to predict patient outcomes in acute stroke which includes an Israeli hospital among its nine partners.
