

## Grangegorman Development Agency Act 2005

- Return new facilities to HSE/DIT and other bodies on completion

## **Grangegorman Urban Regeneration**



#### For the HSE - Securing Social Capital

- Resolves the current poor accommodation of mental health patients
- Adds new community health facilities for the north west city

#### For DIT – Developing Human Capital

- Consolidates 22,000 students and 2,000 staff (9% of sector) to a single location
  - Facilitates a new paradigm in third level education
  - Enhances the student experience through sport, cultural activities
  - Resolves poor accommodation and inadequate facilities
- Enables growth in research, incubation, science and technology business synergies
- Creates a more efficient organisation

#### For the City- Providing Physical, Social & Intellectual Capital


- Links this large site back into the north inner city fabric

#### For the Local community – Underpinning Social capital – Urban transformation





# **Government Decision July 2012**






## **Other DIT Developments**



- Provision of infrastructure will allow self funding elements to progress:
- Student Accommodation:
  - Immediate opportunity for ~600 beds/ 20,000m² / €70M
  - Capacity on site for 1,600 beds
- Sports facilities student levy and sinking fund in place
- Science Park with third parties
- Commercial outlets- shops etc
