



Our outdoor sports facilities are based in Grangegorman and Broombridge which is just two stops away on the luas. New state of the art changing rooms have just been created on our Grangegorman campus. In Grangegorman we have 4 pitches, 2 natural turf for soccer, rugby and GAA, with a further 2 synthetic pitches on campus.

TU Dublin Sports, in collaboration with the Grangegorman Development Agency, opened a brand-new Multi-Sports Playing Area in Grangegorman.

Located adjacent to the Tennis Courts and the All-weather soccer pitch, this area is open for use by TU Dublin students, staff and the local community

This Policy applies to all campuses of the University including research centres. These are all hereinafter collectively referred to as the 'TU Dublin'.


Policy Statement

Biodiversity on Grangegorman Campus

Meadow Grass

One of the best and most successful ways to promote biodiversity is to allow some grass areas to grow to natural meadow grass length, creating grass areas where pollinators can thrive. Further, meadow grass areas provide space where outdoor learning opportunities can take place and where health & wellbeing can be enhanced. An area beside the Phoenix Centre is temporarily being used as a meadow grass. <https://pollinators.ie/practical-advice-on-managing-wildflower-meadows/>



Wildflower Meadow

Experts agree that inadequate nutrition is a major cause of pollinator declines. To have a healthy balanced diet, bees need to be able to feed on pollen and nectar from a range of different flowers from early spring to autumn, from the likes of Geranium & Lavender in May through to Aster & Fennel in October. 


