Programme/Progress

- Bourke Builders have completed most of original works requirements package
- Work inside on removing soft sots of soil under floor slabs
- Work externally on winter temporary storm drain system
- Work externally on sample brickwork wall panel for planners inspection



PRIMARY CARE CENTRE Main Works



Planning Permission

- Planning for Primary Care granted by Dublin City Council on 11th September 2014
- Includes permission to locate 45 car parking spaces behind 226/228 NCR which is within location
 of location for long term carpark basement
- Pedestrian gate allowed on Grangegorman Upper to connect into Campus green fingers beside the primary school. Vehicle gate is for service deliveries

Procurement/Tender Stage 2B works

- Shortlist of Contractors under consideration
- Design team completing tender works drawings and specifications
- Target for Invitation Tender October 2014
- Target works commencement February 2015

COMMUNITY NURSING UNIT



- Feasibility Study almost complete
- Intrinsically linked with NCR car park
- Awaiting 'drop-off' decision
- Report completion end September


DIT CAMPUS – PHASE 1 HANDOVER






