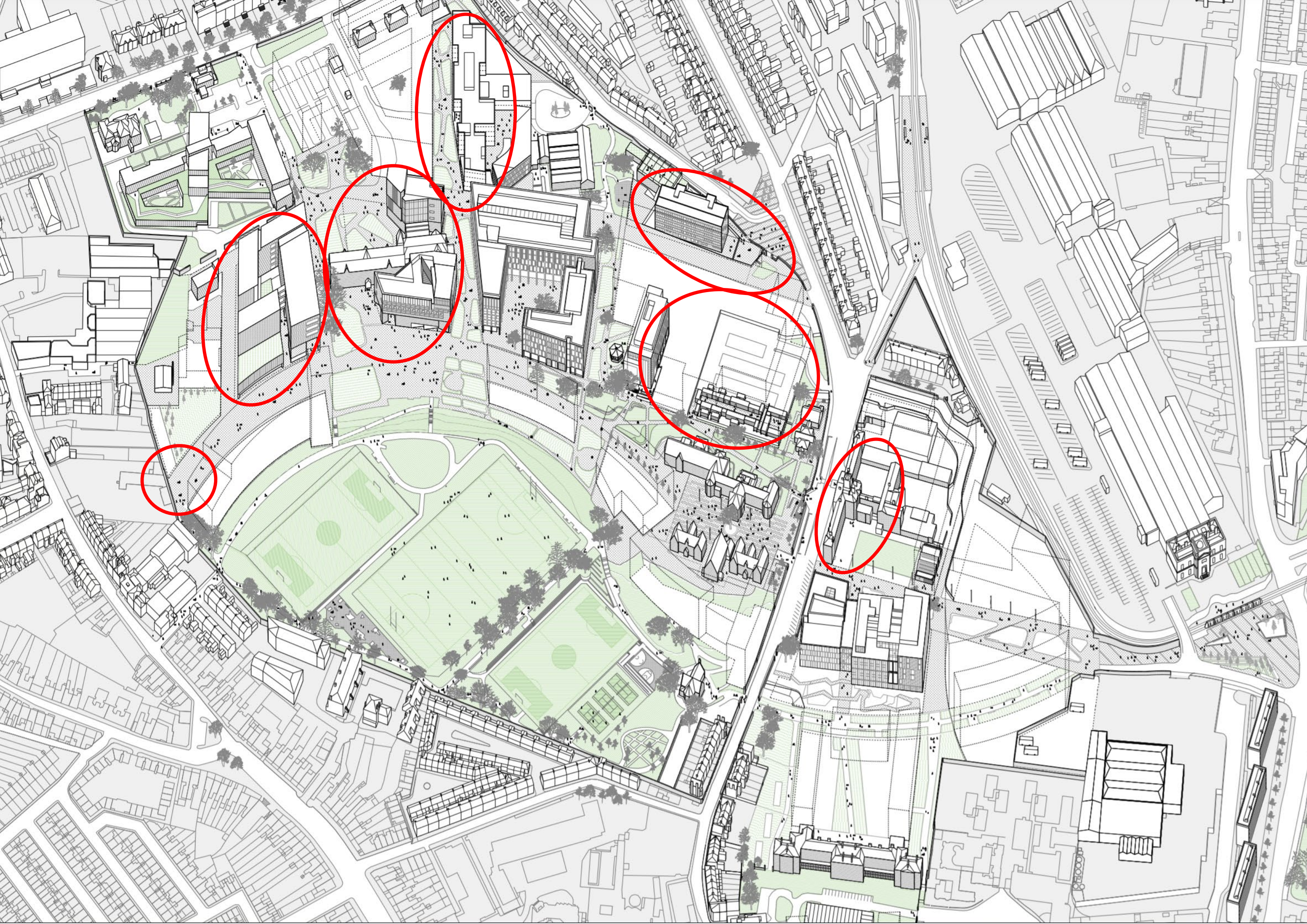

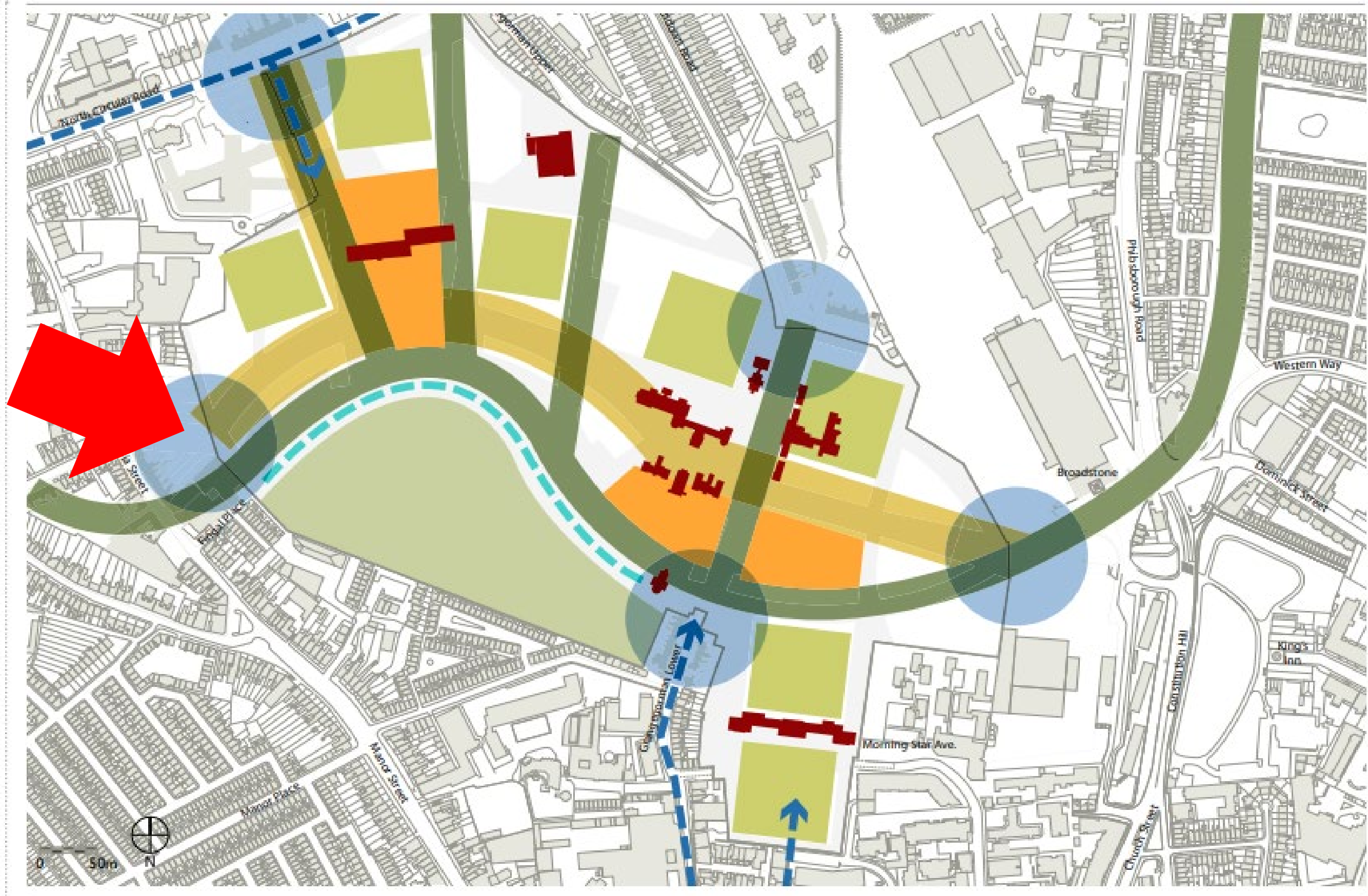


Figure 3.1 Key Structuring Principles which Inform the Overall Urban Form and Layout
